CWA locals 81381, 1170, and 22 at the RGH picket in support of the nurses who unionized









Bonnie regularly volunteers in the food pantry at North Greece Rd Church of Christ as well as cooking for Meals for the Homeless several times a week.

CWA DISTRICT 1: WINNING FOR HEALTHGARE WORKERS & OUR COMMUNITIES

We've had major victories at the bargaining table and in New York State legislation:

2022 Won billions of dollars in the NYS Budget for financially distressed hospitals.

2021 Won landmark Safe Staffing

legislation in New York, establishing a process for setting and enforcing safe staffing minimum standards at hospitals and nursing homes.

2021 CWA Local 1133 members at Mercy Hospital in Buffalo won a 40-day strike and, along with Local 1168, bargained for staffing ratios that set the bar for healthcare worker contracts around the country.

2020 Pushed former Pres. Trump to use the Defense Protection Act during the height of the pandemic to increase production of PPE and ventilators.

2014 Won the New York State Safe Patient Handling Act, establishing hospital policies to protect staff and patients. *If you don't have the lift equipment you need & your manager doesn't help, call your CWA local!*

2010 Won legislation to make it a felony to assault a nurse as part of New York State Penal Code §120.05.

2009 Fought for legislation to ban hospitals from requiring overtime for nurses except in cases of declared emergency.

When we stand together as a union, we can WIN for workers!


