



#### **Labor Management Updates**

A couple of issues came up during Labor Management that the Union received clarification on.

 <u>FMLA No Pay</u> – Bargaining Unit Members were recently notified that they could use vacation and comp time for intermittent FMLA after sick leave was exhausted instead of going straight to No Pay. Members do have the option to save up to 5 days of time if they choose – you do not have to use all of your time before taking No Pay. We were advised this applies to intermittent FMLA as well, but you do have to request the time to be saved.

Attached are the FMLA forms for your doctor to complete and return as well as the FMLA Requests that need to be sent to HR indicating what time you would like to save. This will help members who need to schedule other types of appointments not covered under the FMLA without risk of occurrences.

Informals / Formals on Time & Attendance - Any absences related to COVID were not to be counted as occurrences during the Public Health Emergency and staff should not have had them held against them. Several staff have notified the Union that they received Informals / Formals with COVID related occurrences counted. Members affected bv should contact Michelle.
